The light of Sicilian Lemon and the soft nuances of Peach are enveloped by the bewitching power of Myrrh. In the heart, the uncompromising intensity of Vanilla plays with Saffron in a game of light and shadow.

In the base, the quintessence of preciousness: Patchouli, Sandalwood and the mysterious Incense.

Final touches of Tonka Bean and Musk enhance the soft, powdery afterglow of the fragrance.

As a gourmand touch added to Collection Impériale, Éléonore comes in an orange coffret, recalling the sweetness of a cake and the precious reflections of Amber and Myrrh resins.

The golden and colourful frame on the label, at the crossway between Baroque and Pop styles, is in harmony with the subtle game of opposites the fragrance is made of.
